SACA DISTRICT & STATE SENIOR OLYMPICS Mens and Ladies Divisions

1. Selecting Participant

Participants should be residents, who enjoy competing with others; who are physically able to participate; who are presently residing in nursing facilities; and who were 55 years or older by December 31, 1992.

All Districts must use 4 Age Group Divisions for each Event:

- (1) Women 55~70 years of age
- (3) Women 71 years of age and older
- (2) Men **55-70** years of age
- (4) Men 71 years of age and older

2. Qualifications

Participants should have separate signed releases from their doctor allowing them to travel to and take part in both the District and the State Olympics. A separate signed release from the resident (or guardian) should be obtained and attached to the entry forms. PLEASE USE NEW FORMS ATTACHED

3. Events

A. Wheelchair Race: 3 DIVISIONS

The race is to be run over a measure distance of <u>50 feet</u>. Entrants must be classified as non-ambulatory. Depending on number of participants, qualifying heats and a feature race is recommended. Residents must be entered in the division which matches his/her normal everyday use of a wheelchair.

- 1. Hands Only
- 2. Feet Only
- 3. Hands and Feet

B. Discus Throw: 1 THROW

The discus is a Professional 110 G Model regulation white with gold trim Frisbee. Object is to see who can throw the discus the <u>farthest</u> from a predetermined point. Each resident will be allowed **1 throw**.

C. Shot-Put: 2 THROWS

The shot-put is a regulation softball. Object is to see who can throw the softball the <u>farthest</u> from a predetermined point. Residents may stand at a line as long as the line is not crossed. Each resident will be allowed <u>2 throws</u> to determine the best toss.

D. Bean Bag Toss: 3 THROWS

The bean bag should not weigh over 8 ounces. Object of the bean bag toss is to determine which resident can toss a bean bag into a container with a diameter of no larger than 18" wide and 6" deep the most times out of 3 attempts from a distance of 15 feet.
